**PRICES:** Prices in this catalog are intended for the wholesale trade only (**no retail sales**) and are subject to change without notice. **All prices are F.O.B. Perennial Favorites.** Prices do not include delivery fees or applicable surcharges. List prices are per item for plants purchased in full flats per variety (flats counts as published). Purchases of less than full flats will be charged an additional 10%. The prices listed supersede all previously published prices.

**PAYMENT:** All sales are C.O.D. unless previous credit arrangements have been made. Cash, Check, Master Card, Visa and Discover are accepted. No deliveries will be left without payment in full. A credit application will be sent upon request. Please allow 2-4 weeks for credit clearance. For customers with established credit terms, payment in full is due 30 days from date of pickup or delivery. Any account not paid by the due date will be charged a late fee of 1.5% per month on unpaid balance. Past due accounts will revert back to a C.O.D. basis without further notice. Purchaser agrees to pay all finance charges and all collection fees incurred. **Please remember that credit is a privilege.**

**CLAIMS and WARRANTIES:** All claims must be made within 72 hours of delivery. Any plant returned must be received in good condition within the claim period. **All returns are subject to a 20% restocking fee.** Plants are offered subject to prior sale, no warranty expressed or implied. We do not guarantee survivability of any plant. We strive to insure plants are true to name and in good condition when received. Any plants that prove otherwise will be replaced or purchase price credited. In no case are we responsible for more than the original purchase price of stock sold.

**DELIVERIES:** Perennial Favorites provides deliveries along the Wasatch front with a minimum order of \$500. Please allow 48 hours notice before delivery. **All deliveries are subject to a delivery charge.** Deliveries are made on a regularly scheduled basis (call for details). Those requiring special timing will be charged an additional fee. Any delivery requiring more than unloading in one area close to our truck will be charged an additional fee (\$50 per hour). Landscape deliveries to a job site are subject to an additional charge. Deliveries outside the Wasatch front need to be pre-arranged both for timing and charges. Will-call orders need to be made at least 24 hours in advance. All will-call orders need to be picked up between 8am and 4pm Monday-Friday (closed holidays).

**HOLD and SPECIAL ORDERS:** Orders may be held for up to 14 days with a 25% non-refundable down payment. Orders requiring more than 14 days are subject to a 10% per week maintenance fee. Blooms summer to frost, full sun, this fragrant plant is perfect as a vertical element in containers and borders, drought tolerant after established. Flowers are a pink color. Height 12-15". Zone 5. ○

**Aquilegia canadensis Red and Yellow Columbine**

Red and yellow flowers in April to July, light shade. All parts of plant are poisonous if ingested, water regularly, do not overwater.

Height 12-24". Zone 3. ○ ▶

**Baileya multiradita Desert Marigold**

Foliage deeply lobed, silverish, woolly with bright yellow flowers. Blooms in early spring to mid summer.

Height 12". Zone 5.

**Chamaebariaria millefolium Fernbush**

Intensely aromatic lacy foliage adorned with snowy white flowers. Makes a formal mound with light pruning. Attractive winter seed heads and habit. A tough Western shrub. Blooms July to August. Plant Select.

**Chrysothamnus nauseosus Dwarf Rubber Rabbitbrush**

Drought tolerant, olive green evergreen foliage.

Masses of yellow flowers turn orange as they age. Green foliage changes to a vivid purple-red in winter, vigorous. May-July. Plant Select.

**Oenothera missouriensis Ozark Sundrops**

Rough and tough, native, showy yellow cupshaped flowers, opens in evenings or on cloudy days. Blooms late spring thru late summer.

**Oenothera pallida Mountain Evening Primrose**

White flower with yellow eye and stamens, olive green foliage, drought tolerant.

**Penstemon linarioides var. coloradoensis Silver-ton Bluemat Penstemon**

Spreading mounds of silvery evergreen leaves with lavender blue flowers. May-June. Plant Select.

Height 8-12". Zone 4. ○ ▶

**Penstemon psuedospectabilis Desert Penstemon**

Lavender red to pink leaves are large gray and triangular with sharply toothed margins, boat-like upper leaves are joined together around tall stems. Blooms late spring and is long blooming. Attracts hummingbirds and is rabbit resistant. Drought tolerant

**Penstemon rostriflorus Bridges Penstemon**

Narrow spoon-shaped yellow-green leaves. Large two-lipped scarlet red flowers. Midsummer to fall bloom. Plant Select.

Coral fed, flowers in spring. Will rebloom if deadheaded.

Brilliant cardinal red spires in late summer and fall. Blooms August-October. Attracts hummingbirds. Plant Select.

**Salvia pachyphylla Mojave Sage**

Intensely aromatic evergreen foliage. Silver green leaves set off persistent mauve bracts that surround the flower. June-November. Plant Select.

**Solidago canadensis Baby Gold Goldenrod**

Does not cause hayfever! Dwarf variety, well behaved, golden blooms. Blooms summer.

PERENNIAL GRASS**Calamagrostis acutiflora Eldorado**

New and rare gold variegated form of Karl Foerster. Green leaves with bright gold center which radiates out in the sunlight. Attractive tan wheat-like seed heads appear in early summer and last all season. Needs moisture in hot weather. Cut back to 6" in the spring.

**Carex comans Amazon Mist New Zealand Hair Sedge**

Milky green-on-green reverse Carex. Upright form has twisting tips, suited for small containers and mixed planters.

**Carex commans Prairie Fire**

Unusual olive green arching leaves turning orange in full sun. Moist soil.  
Height 18". Zone 5. ○ ▶

**Carex morrowii Ice Dance Variegated Sedge**

Upright growth, low maintenance but needs regular watering. Green leaves with pure white centers with triangular stems. Prefers wet soil. Good in woodland gardens.

**Carex oshimensis Evergold**

A Japanese sedge that forms a low cascading clump of evergreen leathery leaves with a sunny cream colored stripe down the center. Will tolerate dry shade but prefers moist, rich soil. Mounding growth habit. Good choice for edging, rock gardens, or container plants.

**Hierochloa odorata Sweet Grass**

Fragrant. Used in herbal medicines and alcoholic beverages. Not a drought tolerant plant. Blooms June-October.

**Juncus effusus Big Twister Corkscrew Rush**

Large spiraling foliage resembling giant corkscrews. Can grow in standing water. In hot climates, provide shallow water of 1-6" over the crown. Cut back old stems in late winter.

**Juncus inflexus Blue Arrows Fantastic Foliage Blue Arrows Rush**

Narrow straight gray blue leaves in stiff clumps with golden seed heads. Shallow water.  
Height 10". Zone 4. ○

**Leymus cinereus Magnar Basin Wild Rye**

Erect stems, clump grass, cold hardy, very drought tolerant, and very robust.  
Height 48-72". Zone 2. ○

**Miscanthus sinensis Little Zebra Dwarf Zebra****Grass**

Compact mound of narrow green leaves with horizontal yellow banding. Plumes are reddish purple in late summer. Clump growth habit.  
Height 48". Zone 5. ○

**Pennisetum orientale Karley Rose Oriental Fountain Grass**

Purplish rose plumes from May to frost. Vigorous and very attractive with deep green foliage. Moist soil.  
Height 30". Zone 6. ○

**Schizachyrium scoparium Little Bluestem**

Native American prairie grass. Bluish hue to the leaves. Single white hairy flower cluster at tip of each stalk. Provides cover and feeding sites for ground nesting birds. Will tolerate poor soil. Upright clump habit. Turns orange red in fall.
