Terms and Conditions

PRICES: Prices in this catalog are intended for the wholesale trade only (**no retail sales**) and are subject to change without notice. **All prices are F.O.B. Perennial Favorites.** Prices do not include delivery fees or applicable surcharges. List prices are per item for plants purchased in full flats per variety (flats counts as published). Purchases of less than full flats will be charged an additional 10%. The prices listed supersede all previously published prices.

PAYMENT: All sales are C.O.D. unless previous credit arrangements have been made. Cash, Check, Master Card, Visa and Discover are accepted. No deliveries will be left without payment in full. A credit application will be sent upon request. Please allow 2-4 weeks for credit clearance. For customers with established credit terms, payment in full is due 30 days from date of pickup or delivery. Any account not paid by the due date will be charged a late fee of 1.5% per month on unpaid balance. Past due accounts will revert back to a C.O.D. basis without further notice. Purchaser agrees to pay all finance charges and all collection fees incurred. **Please remember that credit is a privilege.**

CLAIMS and WARRANTIES: All claims must be made within 72 hours of delivery. Any plant returned must be received in good condition within the claim period. **All returns are subject to a 20% restocking fee.** Plants are offered subject to prior sale, no warranty expressed or implied. We do not guarantee survivability of any plant. We strive to insure plants are true to name and in good condition when received. Any plants that prove otherwise will be replaced or purchase price credited. In no case are we responsible for more than the original purchase price of stock sold.

DELIVERIES: Perennial Favorites provides deliveries along the Wasatch front with a minimum order of \$500. Please allow 48 hours notice before delivery. **Deliveries may be subject to a delivery charge.** Deliveries are made on a regularly scheduled basis (call for details). Those requiring special timing will be charged an additional fee. Any delivery requiring more than unloading in one area close to our truck will be charged an additional fee (\$50 per hour). Landscape deliveries to a job site are subject to an additional charge. Deliveries outside the Wasatch front need to be pre-arranged both for timing and charges. Will-call orders need to be made at least 24 hours in advance. All will-call orders need to be picked up between 8am and 4pm Monday-Friday (closed holidays).

HOLD and SPECIAL ORDERS: Orders may be held for up to 14 days with a 25% non-refundable down payment. Orders requiring more than 14 days are subject to a 10% per week maintenance fee. All orders held will receive and purchasers will accept originally held stock. No substituting at time of pick-up or delivery. All special orders or custom orders, need to be arranged for on an individual basis. Fees will be based on the specific needs of both parties. This will require a signed contract.

Tanacetum densum Painted Daisy**Partridge Feather**

Soft silver white leaves with yellow button flowers in early summer. Plant Select Height 8-10". Zone 4. ○

Thelesperma megapotamicum Navajo Tea

An herb used to make medicinal tea by several Native American tribes of the Southwest. Foliage is green and thread-like. Yellow flowers with reddish-brown veins. Blooms summer. Drought tolerant. Height 12-30". Zone 5. ○

Thermopsis divaricarpa Golden Banner

Common native perennial often seen in meadow clearings and along roadways. Bright yellow pea-shaped flowers. Blooms spring to summer. Height 12-36". Zone 4. ○ ▶

Tradescantia tharpaii Prairie Spiderwort

Triangular flowers in shades of rose or purple are borne above clumps of grass-like leaves. This dwarf spiderwort is great for the limited space garden. May go dormant in the summer. Cut back for a second bloom in the fall. Height 12-18". Zone 4. ○ ▶

Viguiera multiflora Showy Goldeneye

Golden yellow flowers with yellow centers. Blooms summer to fall. An intermountain native that can be somewhat aggressive and does well on disturbed sites. Height 24-36". Zone 3. ○ ▶

Zauschneria (Epilobium)**arizonica-Firechalice**

Tubular, showy scarlet-orange flowers. Blooms in late summer to fall. Prefers well-drained soils that thrive on heat and neglect. Height 12-36". Zone 4. ○

Scarlet orange trumpet-like flowers. Taller than Orange Carpet. Utah's Choice. Height 18". Zone 5. ○

Zinnia grandiflora Prairie Zinnia

comans-*Prairie Fire*

Unusual olive green arching leaves turning orange in full sun. Moist soil. Height 18". Zone 5. ○ ▶

comans-*Red Rooster*

Upright, finely-textured, bronze foliage. This one holds the color well. Plumes in late spring. Doesn't mind drier soils. Height 16-20". Zone 6. ○ ▶

flagellifera-*Toffee Twist*

Mounded, slender mahogany leaves. Distinctive as an accent plant or in masses. Grows well in rock gardens. Height 18-24". Zone 7. ○ ▶

morrowii-*Ice Dance Variegata Sedge*

Upright growth, low maintenance but needs regular watering. Green leaves with pure white centers with triangular stems. Prefers wet soil. Good in woodland gardens. Height 12-15". Zone 5. ● ▶

oshimensis-*Evergold Variegata Sedge*

A Japanese sedge that forms a low cascading clump of evergreen leathery leaves with a sunny cream-colored stripe down the center. Will tolerate dry shade but prefers moist, rich soil. Mounding growth habit. Good choice for edging, rock gardens, or container plants. Height 8-12". Zone 5. ▶

testacea-*Orange Sedge*

Mounded, fine-textured glossy foliage. Turns russet orange in the fall. Great for autumn containers. Likes moist, well-drained soil. Height 12-16". Zone 6. ○ ▶

Chasmanthium latifolium *River Mist***Northern Sea Oats**

Upright arching habit. Bamboo-like foliage that changes from green to copper to rich brown with drooping seed plumes. Height 12-26". Zone 5. ○ ▶

Deschampsia caespitosa *Northern Lights***Tufted Hair Grass**

Creamy white with pink variegation. Height 12-18". Zone 5. ○ ▶

Erianthus ravennae *Northern Pampas Grass*

Truly one of the giants of the grass world. The tall flower stalks extend high above the foliage. The foliage is a gray green mound. Prefers well-drained soil and is somewhat drought tolerant. Height 160". Zone 5. ○

Festuca Fescue**amethystina**-*Rainbow Blue Fescue*

Long and slender blue foliage form graceful clumps with orange stalks. Height 24". Zone 4. ○

glauca-*Elijah's Blue*

May be the best blue! Evenly rounded tufts of thin blue grass. Prefers loose, well-drained soil. Height 8". Zone 4. ○ ▶

glauca-*Golden Toupee*

A fine-textured bunch grass with chartreuse golden foliage. Foliage is brightest in spring and greens somewhat in summer. Height 6-8". Zone 4. ○ ▶

idahoensis-*Siskiyou Blue Idaho Fescue*

Clumping habit. Native Idaho blue fescue. Drought tolerant. Height 18". Zone 5. ○

mairei-*Atlas Fescue*

Dense clumping gray green foliage. Coarser textured than other fescues. Height 24". Zone 4. ○

Helictotrichon sempervirens *Blue Oat Grass***Blue Oat Grass**

A beautiful silver blue foliage. Drought and heat tolerant, evergreen. Height 12-36". Zone 4. ○

Sapphire

Bright blue leaves that widen as they mature. Densely packed sprays gently arch upward and fall casually back to the ground at the tips. Likes drier soils. Height 20". Zone 5. ○

Fruits have dark green skin and sweet, smooth orange flesh. Excellent baked or steamed. Stores well. F1 hybrid. Not hardy; grow as an annual. Days to harvest 50. ○



Tomatillo**Physalis ixocarpa Grande Rio Verde**

Tall, branching annual bears tasty berries in the form of tomatillos. The fruit is surrounded by a papery husk, which dries and falls off when ripe. Mildly tart, sweet-sour, but overall pleasant flavor. Excellent used in authentic Mexican salsa and guacamole, or in stewed, fried or baked dishes. Culture is same as for tomatoes. Not hardy; grow as an annual. Days to harvest 60. ○

Tomato**Lycopersicon esculentum****Big Beef**

(AAS) VF1 & 2NT Large, glossy fruit on strong stems. F1 hybrid. Outstanding fresh or cooked. Semi determinate. Not hardy; grow as an annual. Days to harvest 70-75. ○

Cherokee Purple

Abundant, medium-sized heirloom fruits are very sweet and juicy with a smoky flavor. Thick, rosy brown skin resists cracking. Good foliage cover prevents sunburn. Indeterminate. Outstanding eaten fresh and in salads. Not hardy; grow as an annual. Days to harvest 80-90. ○

German Johnson

Super-flavored, red and yellow bicolored fruit has unusually well-defined stripes. Flat, medium to large sized with ribbed shoulders. Indeterminate. Not hardy; grow as an annual. Days to harvest 78. ○

Hamson (DX-52-12)

Bushy, compact growth produces firm red fruit with great flavor; excellent for canning and eating fresh. Developed at Utah State University to set fruit under adverse conditions. Determinate: no staking necessary. Not hardy; grow as an annual. Days to harvest 65. ○

Jet Star

Large, globe-shaped red tomato matures in midseason. Low-acid fruit has a pleasant flavor. Great for fresh eating, cooking or canning. When canning, add some lemon juice. Indeterminate: may require staking. Grow in full sun for sweetest flavor. Not hardy; grow as an annual. Days to harvest 70. ○

La Roma III

Bright red pear-shaped fruit are thick and meaty with few seeds. Great tomato for cooking and canning. Determinate. Not hardy; grow as an annual. Days to harvest 62-75. ○

Lemon Boy

Beautiful bright fruit with mild flavor. Plants adapt well to variable conditions. Wonderful in fresh salads or vegetable trays. Indeterminate: may require staking. Grow in full sun for sweetest flavor. Not hardy; grow as an annual. Days to harvest 72. ○

Lemon Cherry

A summer treat fresh from the vine! Pale yellow fruits have an irresistible sweet, juicy flavor. Pluck some for eating fresh, add whole or sliced to fresh salads, or add some to vegetable trays for colorful garnish. Ideal for container gardening. Not hardy; grow as an annual. Days to harvest 58. ○

Oregon Spring

Early, medium-sized fruits are excellent fresh or cooked. Flavorful flesh and few seeds make this a good choice for sauces. Will set fruit even in cool temperatures. Determinate: no staking necessary. Grow in full sun for sweetest flavor. Not hardy; grow as an annual. Days to harvest 60. ○

Mortgage Lifter

This heirloom is noteworthy for its exceptionally large, meaty, deliciously sweet tomatoes. These tasty, smooth, pinkish-red tomatoes are terrific for sandwiches and slicing. They are borne on indeterminate vines produce heavy yields of 1-2 pound fruits. Not hardy; grow as an annual. Days to harvest 70-80. ○

Pineapple

Unique fruit is yellow and red striped with mild flavor. Tomatoes are delicious eaten fresh from the vine, sliced for salads, or added to sauces and casseroles. Indeterminate: may require staking. Grow in full sun for sweetest flavor. Not hardy; grow as an annual. Days to harvest 90. ○

Supersweet 100

Super-sweet, mouth-watering cherry tomatoes are extra high in vitamin C. High yields are produced throughout the season. A delectable addition to salads and vegetable trays, and for eating fresh. Indeterminate: may require staking. Grow in full sun for sweetest flavor. Not hardy; grow as an annual. Days to harvest 65.

SMALL FRUIT

Strawberry

Fragaria ananassa**Eversweet**

Juicy, vibrant red berries have a sweet, rich flavor; great for jellies, pies and fresh eating. Plants produce two large crops, with sporadic fruiting in between. Young plants form at the end of runners. Use these plantlets to replace older plants. Harvest time spring to summer. Zone 4. ○

Fort Laramie

Sweet, juicy berries are delicious in pies, jellies and for eating fresh. This everbearing variety is among the hardiest and has a tidy growth habit that spreads by runners to form a handsome groundcover. Attracts birds and butterflies. Prefers well-drained soil. Harvest time all season. Zone 4. ○
