TERMS: All sales are C.O.D. unless credit arrangements have been made in advance of delivery. All orders picked up on premises may receive a 3-5% discount depending on methods of payment. No order will be held for more than 2 weeks with 50% down. Open accounts are payable 30 days following the date of delivery. A late payment charge of 1.5% per month on the unpaid balance will be charged on past due accounts.

We must be notified within 72 hours from time of delivery for any and all claims. We do not guarantee plants to live and at no time will we be responsible for more than the purchase price of the nursery stock ordered.

All plants returned must be in good condition and may be subject to a 20% restocking fee. Returns must be made within 3 days of purchase. Items that have not been properly cared for will not be accepted.

DELIVERY: Order of \$300 or more, free delivery from Logan to Spanish Fork (along the Wasatch front). \$299 and less may be subject to a delivery charge. During times of high fuel prices deliveries may be subject to a fuel surcharge.

Landscape deliveries to a job site will be subject to an additional delivery charge.

Deliveries outside the Wasatch front will need to be pre-arranged and there will be a delivery charge depending on the size of the order.

Eriogonum umbellatum *Sulphurflower Buckwheat*

Grows well in a variety of habitats. Requires well drained soils and is drought tolerant. Sulphur yellow flowers that bloom summer through fall. Height 4-12". Zone 3. ○ ▶ Utah's Choice

Fallugia paradoxa *Apache Plume*

Beautiful native shrub with excellent drought tolerance. Does well in rocky, gravelly soils. Seed clusters with feathery tails give it a plume type appearance. White, solitary flowers bloom June through August. Height 60". Zone 3-10. ○

Gaillardia aristata *Blanket Flower*

Showy yellow and red blossoms all summer long. Drought tolerant, long lived perennial that will reseed itself. Height 18-24". Zone 3. ○

Gaillardia pinnatifolia *Hopi Blanketflower*

Easy to grow and a prolific bloomer all summer long. Large flowers with bright red centers surrounded by small, ray type yellow petals. Height 12-18". Zone 3. ○

Geum triflorum *Prairie Smoke*
